Donald G. Sampson is the executive director of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation located in northeastern Oregon, a position he has held since June 2003. As executive director, he is responsible for more than 1,000 employees and a \$97 million operating budget. The CTUIR is the government of the Cayuse, Umatilla and Walla Walla Tribes. They were brought together when the Umatilla Indian Reservation was established by a treaty with the U.S. government in 1855. The confederated single tribe government was esatblished in 1949.

Prior to becoming CTUIR's top staff person, Mr. Sampson was executive director of the Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission for four years and served as Watershed manager at CRITFC for two years. The commission was established by the Yakama, Warm Springs, Umatilla and Nez Perce Indian tribes in 1977 and assists these tribes with management of the Columbia Basin's salmon resources.

Before joining the CRITFC staff, Mr. Sampson was chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, an elected position he held from 1993 to 1997. He is an enrolled member of the CTUIR with Walla Walla tribal heritage.

Mr. Sampson graduated from the University of Idaho with a bachelor's degree in Fisheries Resource Management.

In 2002, the Ford Foundation named Mr. Sampson as a recipient of the Leadership for a Changing World award, a program that recognizes up to 20 community leaders throughout the nation. He also received the University of Idaho College of Natural Resources 2003 Celebrate Natural Resources award.

PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The President's Medallion is presented to individuals who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people, and have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind. At the December 2003 Commencement, we are honoring one extremely deserving individual.



Esther Simplot. One of Idaho's most prominent women, Esther Becker Simplot is at home on the stage of an opera production or riding horseback in the rugged mountains of her adopted state.

Born in Omro, Wisconsin, her appreciation for both music and horses began while living on her father's dairy farm. Following high school graduation as class valedictorian, her love for horses gave way to the arts. After graduating magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in music at MacMurray College in Illinois, she moved to the Chicago area and taught music for two years.

She then moved to New York City to study voice. During her years in New York, she sang with the Riverside Church Choir, the Canterbury Chorale, and the Master Chorale. She also performed in operatic productions and solo concerts, including a recital at

Carnegie Recital Hall and a performance at the New York World's Fair.

While working in New York City and studying to earn a master's degree through the University of Indiana, she met Idaho industrialist Jack Simplot. They were married in 1972. Since that time, she has resided in Boise and traveled throughout the world with her husband.

Through her performances onstage and her work behind the scenes, Mrs. Simplot has energetically shared her devotion and commitment to the performing arts.

She is one of the founding members of the Boise Opera Company and served on its board from 1972 to 1978. She appeared in leading roles for a number of the company's productions.

In 1985, Mrs. Simplot organized and presented a highly successful benefit concert for the arts at Boise's Morrison Center, and in 1986 she performed as a soloist with the Idaho Falls Chamber Orchestra at the Elkhorn Musical Festival in Sun Valley, Idaho. She also has been a soloist with the College of Idaho Symphony and has performed in many concerts throughout the Pacific Northwest.

In May 1991, Mrs. Simplot organized a community fund-raising campaign to finance the renovation of the Hendren Furniture building in downtown Boise. Just 15 months later, the historic structure, named the Esther Simplot Performing Arts Center, became home for the Boise Philharmonic, Boise Opera, Inc., and Ballet Idaho.

Mrs. Simplot was a member of the Smithsonian National Board from June 1994 to June 1995. She was the first Idahoan to serve in that capacity. In April 1999, Mrs. Simplot was elected to the Velma V. Morrison Center for the Performing Arts Hall of Fame.

HONARARY DEGREE

Honorary degrees may be awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the state of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or UI graduates.

Mr. Jacklin's support of the University of Idaho's land-grant mission is recognized through the Riverbend Commerce Park. A spirit of cooperation between the university and Jacklin Seed led to the development of the University of Idaho Research Park at Post Falls. Because of the vision and entrepreneurial flair of Jacklin and his brothers, this strong partnership supports economic development in northern Idaho. The synergy between research and business at the research park will provide a growing, unprecedented impact on Idaho's economy.

Mr. Jacklin's public service focuses not only on the University of Idaho, but the entire state. He serves on the Idaho Association of Commerce and Industry and is the northern Idaho representative on the Idaho Community Foundation Board. He has given unselfishly of his time, energy and financial resources in his passion for the state of Idaho.

A native of Spokane, Washington, and a graduate of Washington State University and Purdue University, Duane Jacklin is widely respected for his wisdom, knowledge and integrity. He is committed to making life better for everyone in Idaho.

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Gowns.

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator —gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps-

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods-

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

Honor Cords—

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the

university commencements.

Silver E Gold W O O I G

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and
