Also talked to a hunter about deer population on Big Creek. Marmots are out! Trimmed mule manes it ails.

Thursday March 11
Checked traps,
Wrote up /sent Devlieg Cabin committer cor meeting minutes. Discussed purchases with Janet $P$ : Jim A. Ordered fan to boost hydropower production and
discussed options with Scott at GN Backwoods Solar. Emails on NSF, bat workshop, DeVlieg Cabin. Ray made 3 flights with helicopter fuel (e barrels) and propane (2) - muddy strip hard for the 2 of us to unload barrels. Jim $\sum_{1}^{i}$ Haiti met with Larry Kingsbury, Forest Archaeologist about Sheepeater Indians (Hati's display) and settler communications (Jim's display). Jim made calls on cabin purchases !deck construction; met with FS Clem Pope and Mary Faurot about special use permits, use of Cold Mdws Guard Station by Troy, and fish talk at $T R$ and predation talk at FS McCall.

Robins, juncoes, Ru blackbirds at TR.

Jim met with Stere Nadeau IDFG for funding on Troy's undergrad elk project -no luck. More deck construction coordination calls.

Saturday March 13
Worked up 2 months of satellite phone bills. Emailed whom Gorman on deck materials purchase \& logistics. Turned on water to the lab - not frozen, but a pipe is broken (inside the wall) at the main shower - Knob had not been lifted to release water pressure last fall. Too much work to get into the plumbing today. Checked Duplex water line - good flow to Pioneer Creek, but no flow on to Duplex. Checked wolf trap telemetry (3) and I visual check. 2 marmots out. First 2 bats of the year at our window eating moths, Striped skunk on backporch - yesterday I found an empty plastic lunchmeat wrapper - from his meal the night before. Jim and Hati attuned the Traditimal Archery Expo. in Ontario, OR. Hati got to visit with several plopte who have bowhunted in Africa. Purchased 10 begs of fled via UI card ( $\left.6-80^{*}, 4-50^{\#}\right)$

Ne Sunday, MaR. 14
Did some early morning shopping Then drove from MCcall to Cascade. Ray flew us in@9am. Worked. on the lab plumbing - had to cut in to the wall and fix broken solders. Holly did additional soldering be low bldg. I skied Rocky, Cricket (fronts) and Shill rear (tightened fronts too). Corresponded sural times with J. Pope regarding tody. truss a hanged. Snow $1 / 2$ gone in main pasture now.
Monday, Mar. 15
Did many emails (Cabin related) before we saddled stock and headed to $C_{a}$ bin $C_{R}$. to meet the 15 u/uF group coming from east iv west. Met up with Wayne W., Dave D., Katik. and Kirsten as they hiked down Cabin CR. Back at TiP., Hati fixed ap the lab/bath wall and clennal up. Pay brought in 5 tags fud. Stine lope 3
barbels hell:- fuel from Challis.
