

ArcGIS Desktop 10.6 Student Trial Software Instructions

The ArcGIS Desktop 1-year Student License provides a 1-year term license for ArcGIS Desktop and Extensions and is limited to educational purposes (no commercial use allowed). Each authorization code is valid for one user on one computer.

1. Before you install ArcGIS for Desktop

- a. Check your [system requirements](#) to make sure your computer has the hardware and software required to run ArcGIS Desktop.

2. Request an authorization code

- a. From your UI Email account, send an email to Bruce Godfrey (bgodfrey@uidaho.edu) to request an authorization code.

3. Activate your authorization code

- a. Visit www.esri.com/educationedition to begin the process of activating and downloading your ArcGIS for Desktop Student Trial software.
- b. Log in using your existing Esri Account, or Sign-up for a new Esri Account, if necessary.
- c. Enter the authorization code you received in Step 2 and click the 'Activate ArcGIS' button.
 - If you created a new account thereby navigating away from the page to enter your authorization code return to www.esri.com/educationedition and sign in.

4. Follow the steps that appear on screen to download, install, and authorize ArcGIS 10.6

- a. Select the button "ArcGIS 10.6" and then download the item "ArcGIS Desktop (ArcMap)".



Note: If you received the ArcGIS Desktop software from your instructor or from Information Technology Services, simply skip the download step and proceed to the install and authorize steps.
