



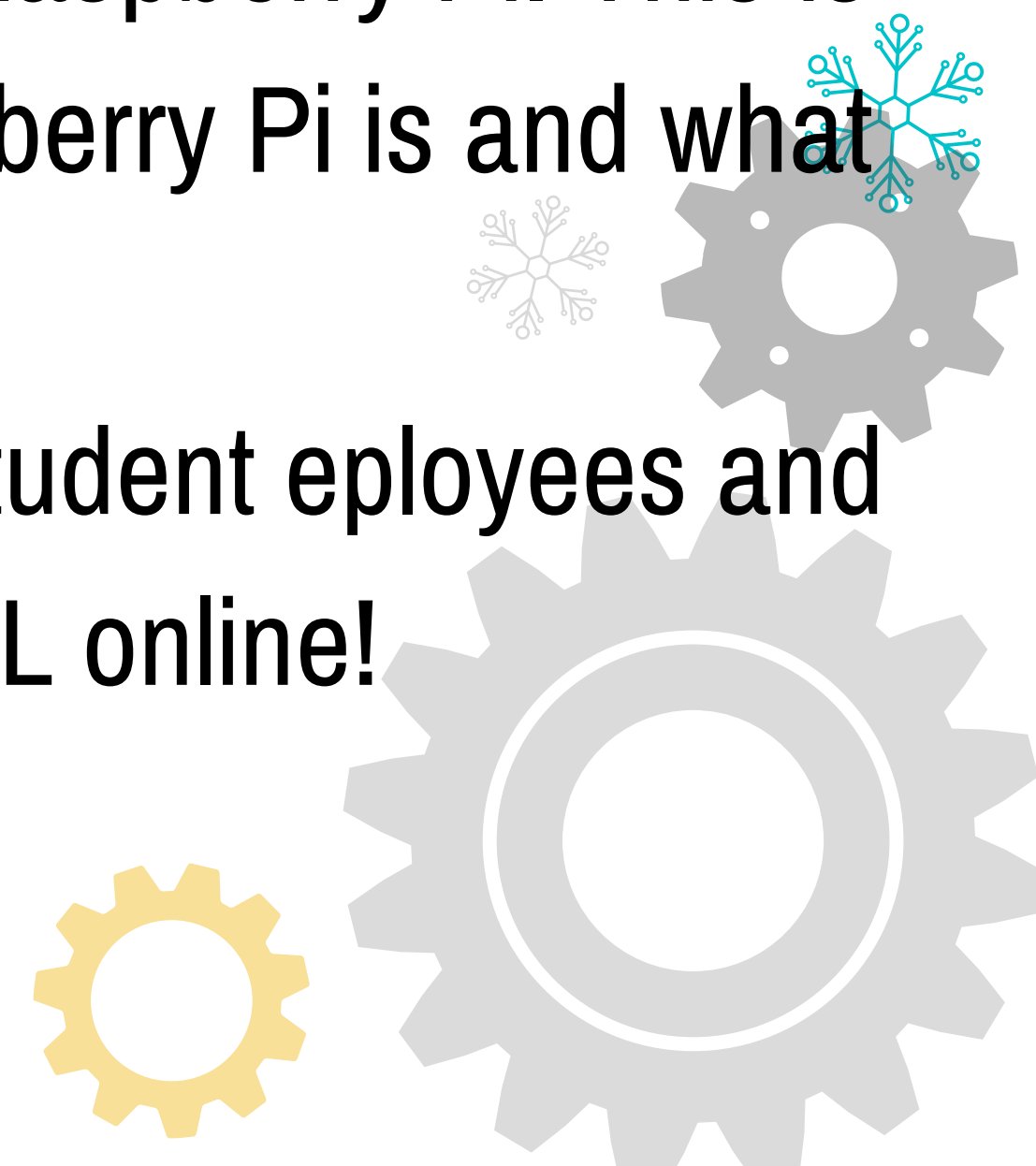

This semester we also hired two new student employees and brought our new Mobile MILL online!



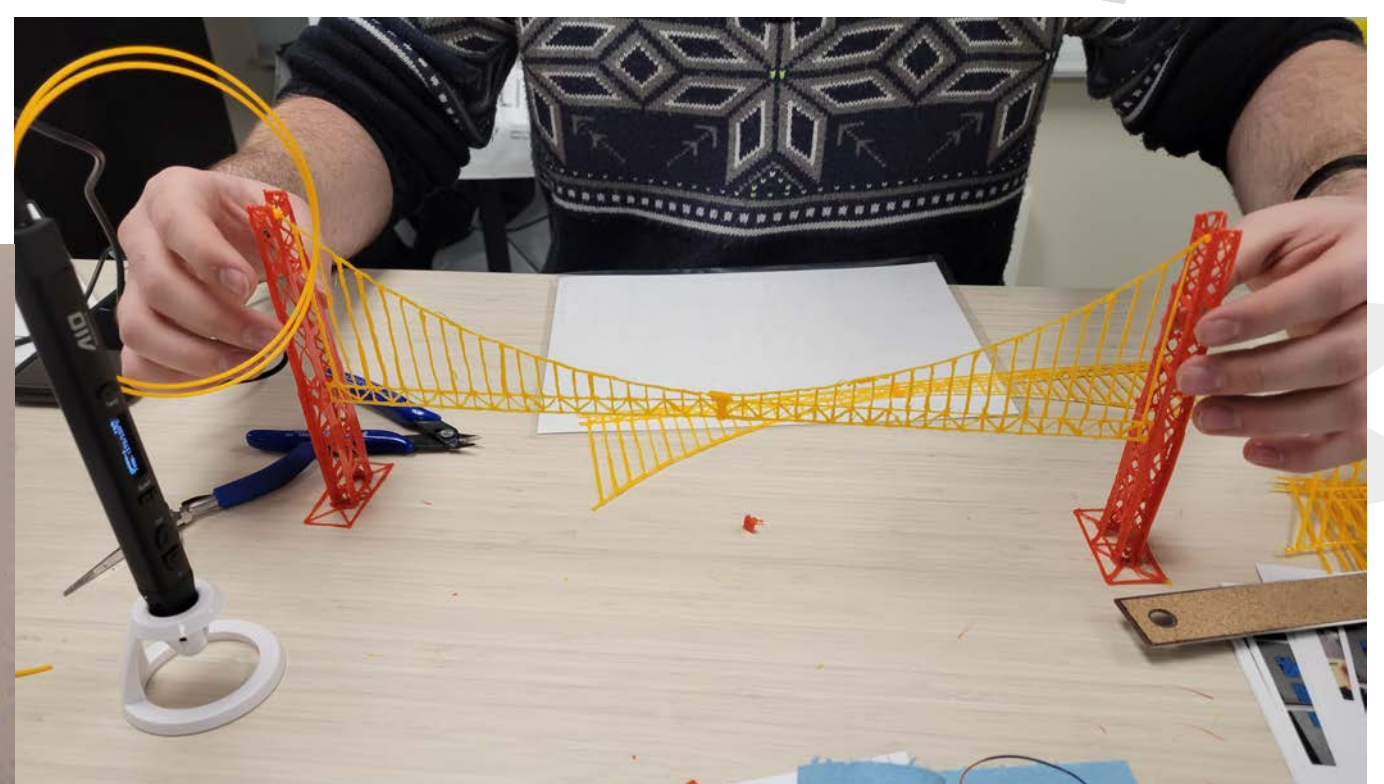
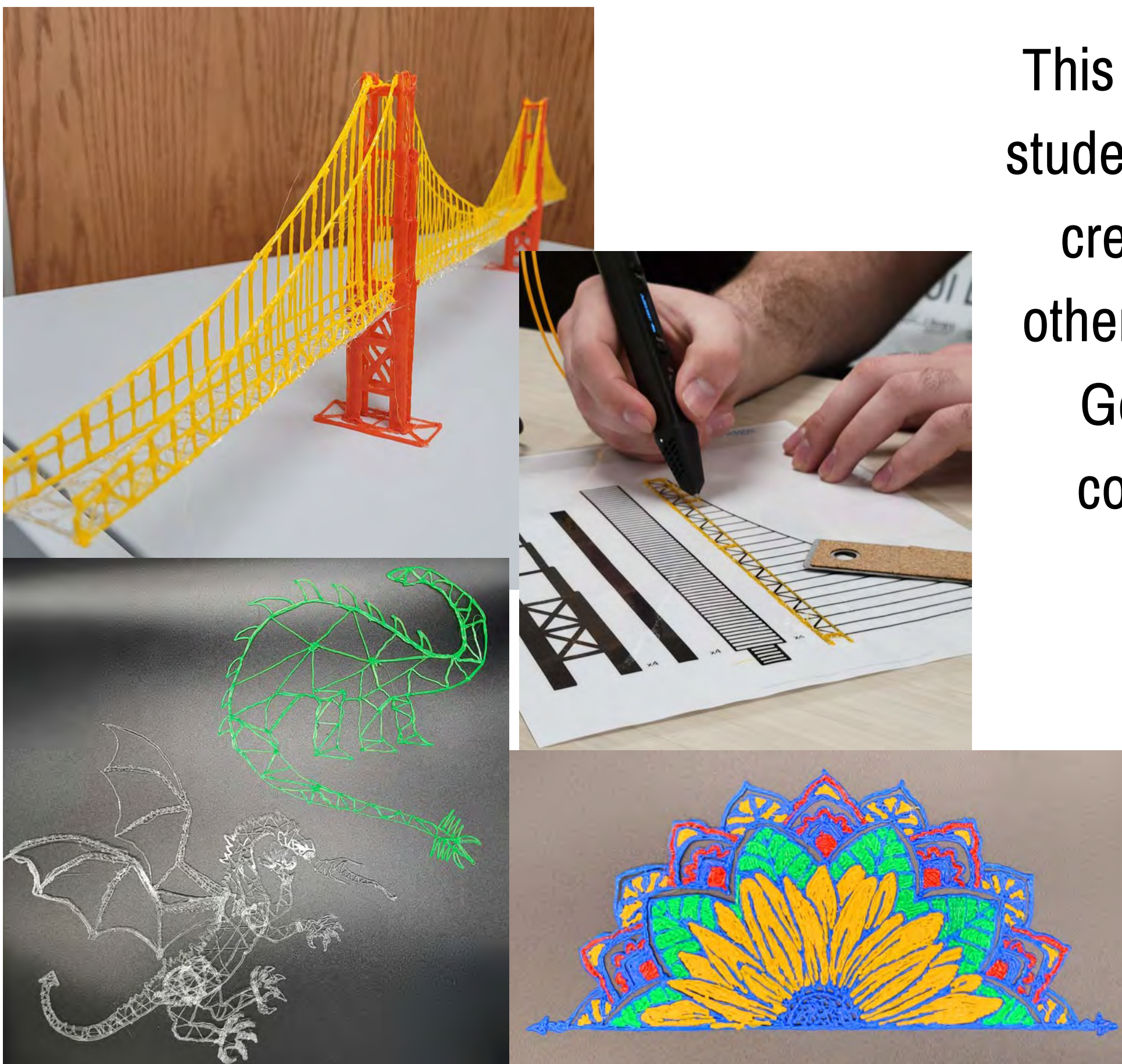
Introduction to Student Workers

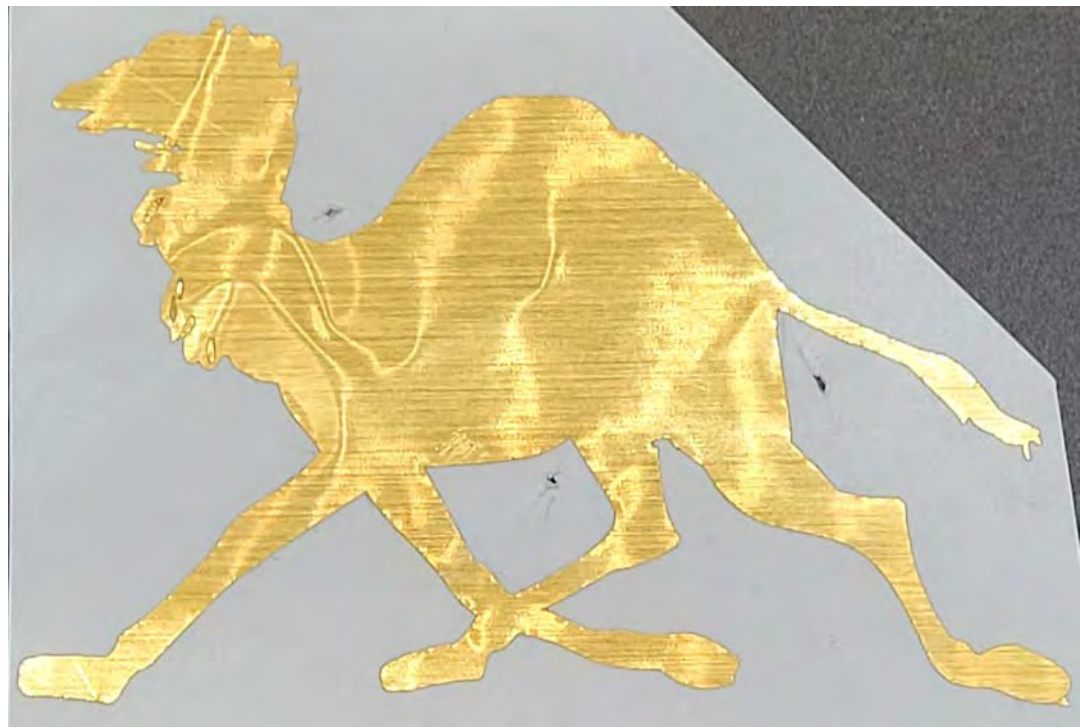
Biweekly Event: 3D Pens

Vinyl Stickers is always a popular workshop. We have had students coming in and learning how to make stickers throughout January. Here are some of the highlights from their creativity.

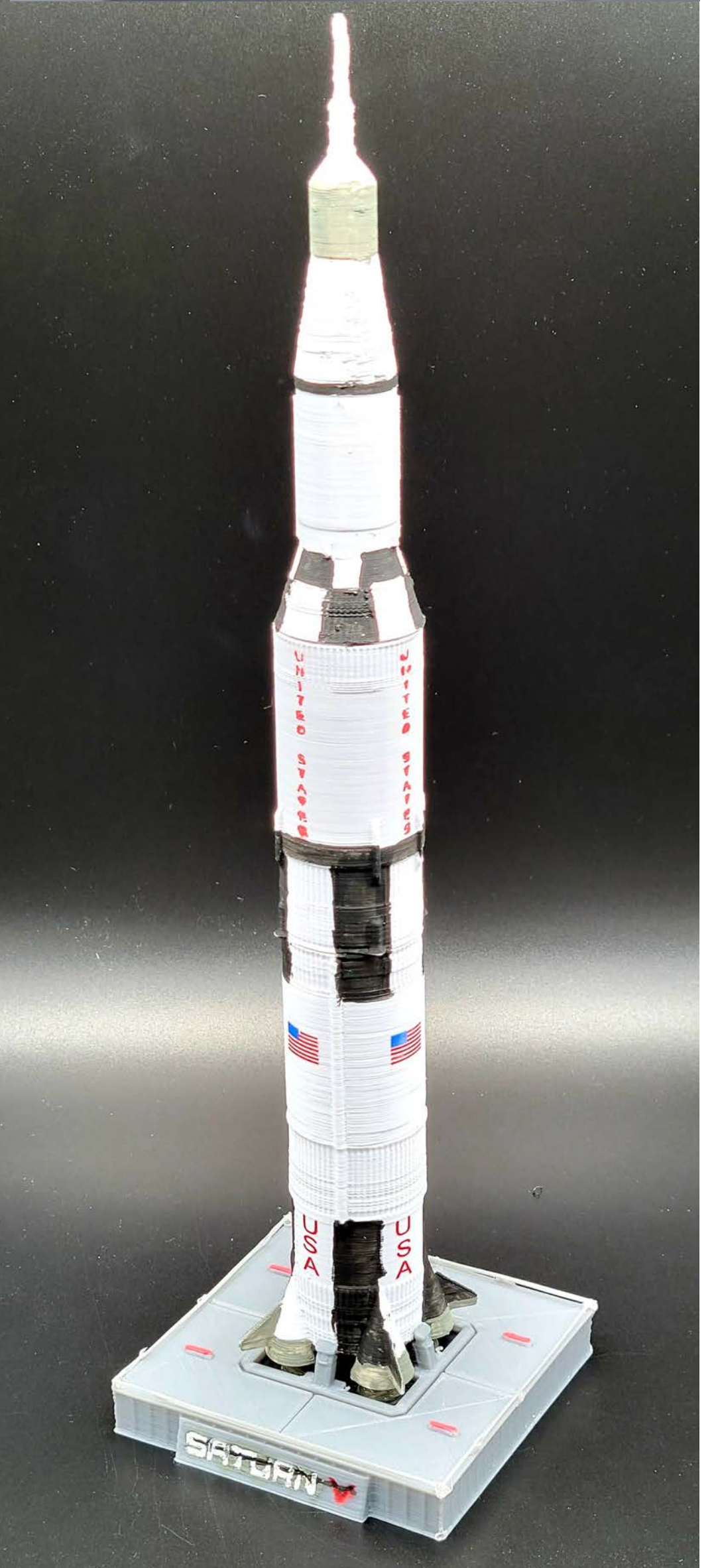


Mobile MILL News!
