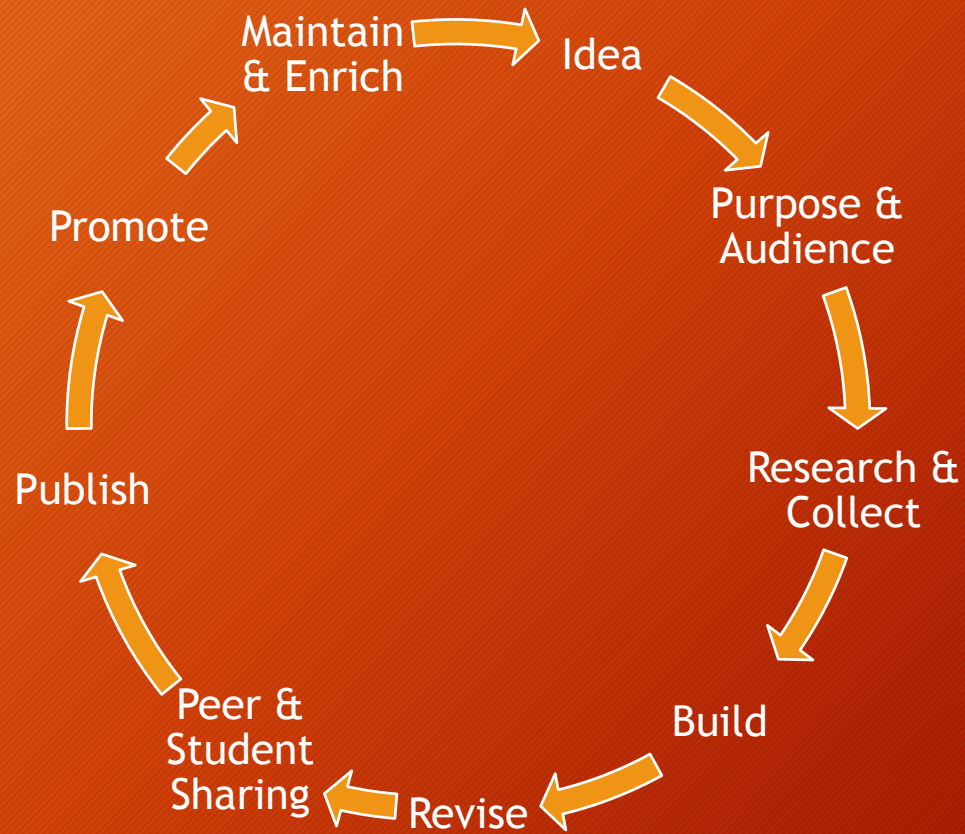

- Form a team of content specialists (including subject experts for research and technology experts)

# Scholarly and Pedagogical Contributions: New Perspectives on Hemingway?

- “Places” the oral histories and brings together Hemingway’s Idaho years in one centralized location with multi-media format.
- Videos, 2D/3D visualizations that accompany biographical information highlight the complexity and contradictions of his personality and of his time in Idaho.
